



Dierks Bentley Releases New Elle King Duet 'Different for Girls'

Dierks Bentley has announced his new single, the follow-up to the two-week Number One "Somewhere on a Beach." Titled "Different for Girls," the song is a duet with "Ex's & Oh's" singer Elle King and marks the second release from his new album *Black*, out tomorrow.

In a release, King admits she was shy about performing other people's songs, but was thrilled by the results. "Since I often write from the male perspective, I was really excited to be a part of someone else's story that is jumping outside of the norm for a relationship song. The lyrics are really smart and I love that he is bringing a lot of attitude to modern country music."

Bentley views "Different for Girls" as the first step toward maturity for the main character of *Black*, an album about the ups and downs of a long-term relationship. Some of it draws from his own marriage, Bentley told Rolling Stone Country. "My wife is cool enough to let me write about personal things, to be a songwriter exploring the shadowy sides of love," he says. "It's personal to us, but I also want it to be universal."
