Jason Aldean, Chris Young turn Opry pink for breast cancer



In honor of breast cancer awareness month, Jason Aldean flipped a switch Tuesday night to turn the famed Opry barn pink during the annual Opry Goes Pink event, which this year partnered with Aldean's 11th Concert for the Cure to raise money for the fight against breast cancer.

The Opry staged two shows as part of Opry Goes Pink and Concert for the Cure, which included performances from Aldean, Hillary Scott & The Scott Family, Montgomery Gentry, Chris Young with surprise guest Cassadee Pope, Jeannie Seely, and Mickey Guyton.

“I’m lucky to be surrounded by a lot of amazing women in my family, management and publicity team,” Young said. “It means a lot to me to be part of Opry Goes Pink and Women Rock for the Cure in support of the fight against breast cancer.”

Proceeds from Tuesday night’s events benefited Nashville-based non-profit Women Rock for the Cure that supports young women fighting breast cancer. Aldean also presented a check to the Susan G. Komen Foundation with funds raised on his 2016 Six String Circus Tour that boosted his contributions to fight the disease to \$3.3 million dollars. Aldean has been a dedicated supporter of the fight against breast cancer since losing a friend to the disease in 2004.
