## Kip Moore brings hits, surprises to Ryman



Kip Moore delivered a slew of hits, some new songs and a surprise guest during his sold-out headlining show at Ryman Auditorium Friday night.

The country singer kicked things off with new song “Wild Ones” and filled his set with his No. 1 hits “Somethin’ ‘Bout a Truck,” “Beer Money” and “Hey Pretty Girl.” Fans also sang along with album cuts “Drive Me Crazy” and “Everything But You” and even knew the words to “Backseat,” which he frequently plays live but has never been released.

Moore delivered a few cover songs including the chorus of Kris Kristofferson’s “Sunday Morning Coming Down,” which he said is the song that made him want to move to Nashville.

“I can’t believe I’m standing in this place right now,” Moore said from the stage. “It’s surreal to me.”

Toward the end of the night, Moore brought out Jewel to duet on new song “Separate Ways.”
