Hillary Scott, Charles Kelley and Dave Haywood recently teamed up with the household megastore to release the “Heartland” collection, which features everything from animal-printed decorative pillows to plaid-patterned bedding sets, and ranges in price from \$40 to \$180, which will make it even easier to add a little “down-home” flair to your house.

But even though it might seem strange for a group that spends so much time on a tour bus to design a home collection, it was actually the band's travels that helped inspire Lady Antebellum to get in touch with their inner designers in the first place.
