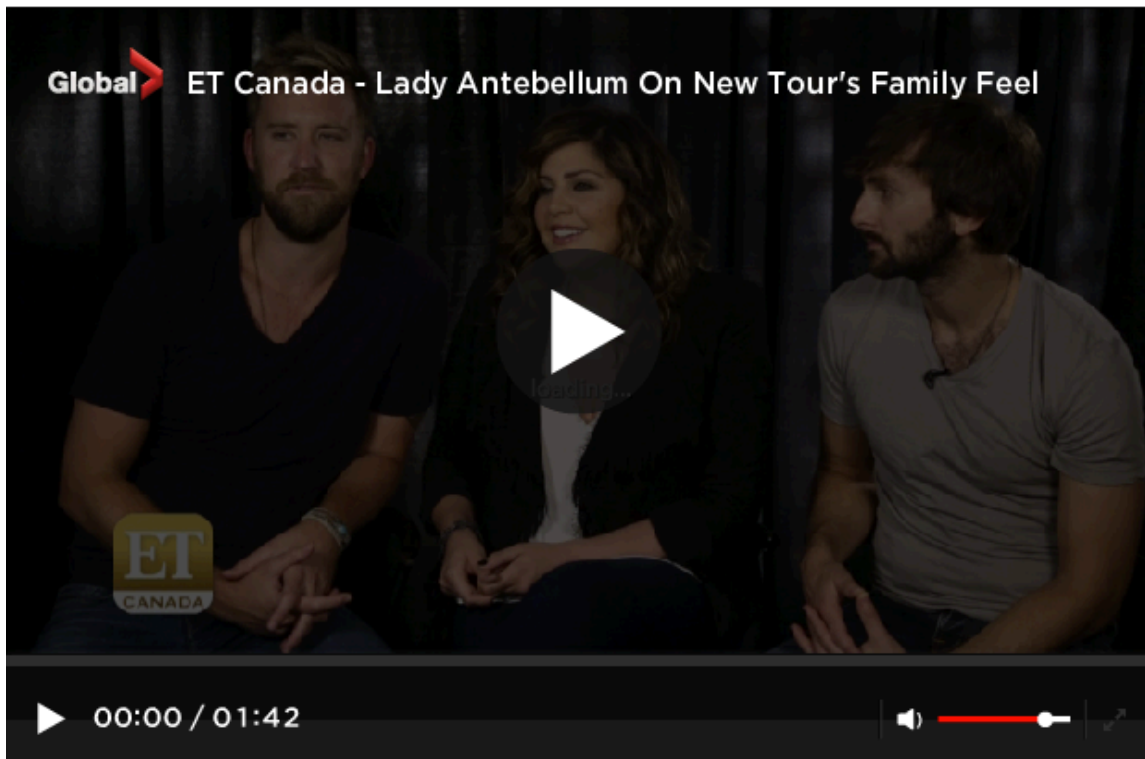




Lady Antebellum Make It A Family Affair
