Watch: Iowa QB belts out tune with country star Tucker Beathard



Two worlds collided on-stage earlier this season at Iowa's Kinnick Stadium, different paths to stardom that happened to start under the same roof.

Nashville singer-songwriter Tucker Beathard, who's gaining momentum in country music, sang alongside Iowa quarterback and older brother C.J. Beathard on Aug. 27 during the special tune, "I'll Take On The World With You", one he wrote for his siblings.

"Ever since C.J. started at Iowa, playing a show at Kinnick Stadium was one of those unreachable dreams that you never think will actually come true," Tucker Beathard said.

"Our whole family lives for sports and music, it's what bonds us together going back to my grandpa and his years in the NFL.

"It was awesome to be invited to the Back Porch Revival and to see those two worlds collide in front of a stadium full of people. I'll never forget it."

Later this fall, Beathard will continue his musical march across the country with a special stretch he's calling the Rock On College Tour, playing several dates in Big Ten towns beginning in Champaign, Illinois on Oct. 13.

"If I learned anything from growing up on a field surrounded by coaches and athletes, it's that you have to keep your head down and keep practicing," Beathard said in a release. "Two hundred shows later, and I think we are ready to go tackle our first club tour."
